I. Call to Order

Chairman Thornbury called the meeting to order at approximately 6:00 pm.

A. Calendar

B. Finance/Budget

Members wanted budget and financial reports to include percentages used and available. Discussion took place regarding the checks written to vendors for withholdings deducted from employee's checks. Mrs. Ratliff inquired if there was a way for members to see a list of those deduction amounts so members can verify that monies deducted from employee pay was the amount being sent to the various payroll vendors. Superintendent Green and Finance Officer Denise Clark explained the monthly financial summary information and a brief description of the various funds and how they are utilized.

Chairman Thornbury asked that the regular monthly meeting agenda be published for members to review earlier. Members agreed to move the agenda schedule for members from Friday to Thursday before the Tuesday regular meetings.

D. Drug/Smokeless Tobacco

Superintendent Green explained the use of the dog within the building and on the school grounds.
