RE: Board Agenda Item –Acceptance of Proposal from WPC for the Security Upgrade Projects at the Bullitt Alternative Center and Riverview Opportunity Center

The Department of Facilities received and opened sealed proposals for the security upgrade projects on February 19, 2019 @ 2:00 p.m. The following firms submitted proposals for the project:

• WPC Co., Inc.	\$ 84,542.00
• McDuffie Construction LLC	\$105,416.00
• Kevco Construction	\$111,054.00

The apparent low bidder is WPC Co., Inc. Sarah Dalga, architect with Studio Kremer Architects, has met with the contractor and has verified that all items have been included and a complete, responsible bid package has been submitted. The original budget for the project was \$60,000.00. After consulting with Lisa Lewis, we recommend revising the BG-1 to reflect the proposal submitted by WPC Co., Inc. and move forward with the project. Doing so will bring these facilities to the same security standards provided to our other educational buildings. The additional funding will come from the Maintenance budget.

I recommend the Board accept the proposal from WPC for the security upgrade projects at the Bullitt Alternative Center and Riverview Opportunity Center.

 - (ii) Be in continuous compliance with the provisions of KRS Chapters 136, 139, 141, 337, 338, 341 and 342 that apply to the contractor or subcontractor for the duration of the contract.
- (b) A contractor's failure to reveal such a final determination of a violation by the contractor of KRS Chapters 136, 139, 141, 337, 338, 341 and 342 or to comply with these statutes for the duration of the contract shall be grounds for the Board's:
 - (i) Cancellation of the contract; and
 - (ii) Disqualification of the contractor from eligibility for future contracts awarded by the Board for a period of two years.
- (c) A Subcontractor's failure to reveal such a final determination of a violation by the subcontractor of KRS Chapters 136, 139, 141, 337, 338, 341, and 342 or to comply with these statutes for the duration of the contract shall be grounds for the disqualification of the subcontractor from eligibility for future contracts for a period of two years.


