

2019 Application and Recommendation for The Children's Assistance Grant Prince Hall Conference of Grand Matrons and Grand Patrons Order of the Eastern Star

Purpose of Agency: The purpose of the Nelson County Early Learning Center and Early Childcare Center is to provide quality early education and childcare services with a strong focus on the whole child. We are committed to this mission by ensuring that all teaching staff have obtain their Bachelor's Degree in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education with five of those teachers holding a Master's Degree. Fifty Percent of our childcare staff hold a Childcare Development Associate's Degree while the other fifty percent hold a Commonwealth Child Care Credential.

Accomplishments of Agency and cite examples of service rendered on behalf of children: The Nelson County Early Learning Center and Early Childcare Center received a five star rating through the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services All Stars accreditation. The Early Learning Center is also certified through the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale. In addition to early childhood education, the center provides additional support services for our students to include early identification of students with special needs through our Special Education Department. We also provide a family resource center to remove any non-cognitive barriers to our student's education and provide resources and support to their families.

Approximately how many children have benefited from the service of this agency: There are approximately 320 students enrolled this year at the Early Learning Center and Early childcare Center.

Why does your jurisdiction feel this agency deserves consideration for this award? The Nelson County Early Learning Center and Early Childcare Center serves approximately 320 students. Of those 320 students, over 50% of our student population financially qualify for free lunch assistance. If awarded this grant, the Nelson County Early Learning Center and Early Childcare Center will purchase needed items to support student success at school. These items will include: backpacks, school supplies, clothing, shoes, and hygiene products.
