



District Sponsored Programming

- 50 teachers have confirmed projects
- 1,000 anticipated students to be served

Community Sponsored Programming

- 30 community partners have confirmed projects
- 2,500 anticipated students to be served (contingent on staffing)





Challenges

- Aging buildings (newest high school is 50 years old)
- Poor facility infrastructure



Building the Future

Improvement Strategies

- Create five 21st century learning environments
- Increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the use of existing facilities
- Regularly analyze bus routes
- Monitor implementation of the USDA audit recommendations
- Develop business continuity plan



Operations – Outcome Data

- Approval of the construction of three new elementary schools
- Approval of the construction of one new middle school
- A full scale renovation of The Academy @ Shawnee
- Provided targeted behavior support strategies to staff, including 1,246 bus drivers
- 1100 site visits conducted to monitor compliance with nutrition services requirements



IDEA

Challenges

- ARC decision processes
- Compliance in every school site
- Disproportionality in discipline

Improvement Strategies

- Weekly meetings with KDE
- Funded ECE Implementation coach for all schools
- Provide on-going professional development
- Conduct regular desk audits to monitor implementation
- Collaborate with other departments to improve services for students





IDEA – Outcome Data

- 1,260 desk audits conducted this year
- 100% principals and assistant principals signed commitment to fulfilling IDEA requirements
- 8% reduction in suspension incidents for ECE students
- 7% increase in ECE students meeting MAP reading growth benchmarks
- 8% increase in ECE students meeting MAP math growth benchmarks
