

Separated some of the codes with multiple and different behaviors



Added behavior code options for bus behaviors



Removed "Refusal to Respond to Questions or Requests" and attempted to add objective alternatives

# BEHAVIOR LEVEL CLARITY & RESOLUTIONS



Removed the multiple references to behavior levels and created one clear chart



Added resolutions to expand options around mental health and restorative practices



Ensured that every option available in IC as a response, intervention, or resolution is defined for stakeholders

# PROACTIVE SUPPORTS



Combined multiple charts and tables into clear classroom, school wide, and bus related proactive supports and suggestions for responding to behavior



Ensured that listed suggestions were proactive



Added suggestions for non-punitive ways to address student misbehavior

# PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE & DUE PROCESS



Created a more coherent sequence



Simplified the appeals process for suspensions



Revised procedures for ECE students

# INTRODUCTION & SINGLETONS



Provided stakeholders a coherent explanation of the 3 Pillars for Success, the 6 Systems, and how they connect to supporting student behavior



Elevated sections by moving them to the beginning of the document



Incorporated isolated sections into relevant areas of the Handbook
