

Parent Involvement Report

April 18, 2019

As a result of the 2019 Parent Teacher Conferences conducted in February, the schools reported the following participation:

Franklin Elementary -had **229** students represented during Parent Teacher Conferences for Kindergarten.

Simpson Elementary- had **831** parents involved since the beginning of the new year. 372 Parent Teacher conferences occurred in person, student-led, or by phone. 161 attended the Math and Literacy night, 135 attended the All Pro Dads event and 163 participated in the Easter lunch

Lincoln Elementary-had **463** parents/guardians involved since the beginning of the new year. 302 parent/guardians participated in the spring Parent Teacher conferences. 64 attended Honoring Excellence, 75 watched the play, and 22 participated in the Hype Rally.

Franklin-Simpson Middle School- had a total of **242** parent contacts. Team Honor met with 40 parents, Team Courage had 27 parent contacts, Team Hope made 46 parent contacts, Team Integrity had 29 parent contacts, Team Respect had 25 parent contacts, Team Perseverance had 70 parent contacts, and Team Caring made 3 parent contacts. Related Arts had 2 parent contacts.

Franklin-Simpson High School-had a total of **147** Parent Teacher Conferences. Parent contact has been added to Weekly Overviews.

Franklin Simpson-West Campus- had a total of **24** students represented in conferences.

Total Parents Involved= 1,936 This is a decrease from the Fall conferences. However, it is an increase from the same time last year by 268 contacts. We will continue to strive for ways to improve the communication with guardians. We realize that engaging ALL stakeholders, especially our parents, will increase student achievement.
