- The focus of this month's work has been on preparing testing accommodation and modification report needed to ensure students identified with special needs receive testing accommodations and/or modification during K-PREP as outlined on their IEP. Special Education Department Staff verifies all Private School Plans, 504 Plans, and Individual Education Program.
- This summer we will provide twelve days of summer school services to support academic, life skills, and involvement in the community for students identified with Moderate to Severe Disabilities. The focus of direct instruction will target Daily Living Skills (ordering from menus, using apps. to order food/home products, doing laundry, etc.). Math, reading, and communication will also be targeted to reinforce skills taught during the 2018-19 school year. Students will have the opportunity to explore joining organizations such as, Girl and Boy Scouts and Girls and Boys Club. Currently, there are eleven students scheduled to participate.
