PROFICIENCY EVALUATION:

Pursuant to, 16 KAR 5:030, Proficiency Evaluation, require that educators and other professional school personnel hold certificates of legal qualifications for their respective positions to be issued upon completion of programs of preparation. The traditional means of recognizing competency and proficiency for educator preparation is by earning academic credits. This administrative regulation provides an alternate means for recognizing competency and proficiency other than academic credit.

- Successful completion of Praxis assessments
- Interview with Candidate
