<u>Action/Discussion Item:</u> Approve Prestonsburg Elementary School to work with Kona Ice for a Schoolwide fundraiser.

<u>Applicable Statutes or Regulation:</u> Floyd County Board of Education Policy #9.33- Fundraising Activities - All School Wide fundraising activities must be approved by the Board of Education.

<u>Issue:</u> The additional funding generated through the fundraiser will help improve the instructional opportunities for students and help provide needed supplies. The sale will take place once a month every month of the school year 2019-2020. The profits from the sale will be used for instructional supplies, Accelerated Reader Program, field trips, incentives, co and extra-curricular groups and other areas as deemed necessary.

<u>Background:</u> PES has had a school-wide fundraiser via PTA for several years. This year (19-20) like last year 18-19 the school activity account will be responsible for collecting, receipting and depositing the money.

<u>Budge/Financial Issues</u>: No financial issues for the District. PES will receive 34% of the profits and no up-front expenses will be occurred.

Alternative: The Board may deny the agreement request.

<u>Recommended Action:</u> Approve Prestonsburg Elementary to work with KONA ICE in a school-wide fundraiser.

Rationale: This will help continue the instructional process and afford students new opportunities for instructional delivery and opportunities.



Be that student that shows their inner colors by having admiration for authorit for other people, for self, for property and for country.




Each month, a different Character Trait Gift will be available for FREE when a student purchases a \$5 King Kona
