Members must complete 300 hours of service from September 1 to the end of the school year. About 8 hours each week. Service outside regular school hours is highly encouraged.

1. What service/volunteer opportunities will you involve the youth service member in? How do those activities promote career exploration? What opportunities can you offer that will allow your student to complete 300 hours? How will you help keep your student on track to finish service by the end of school? Applicant will assist with programs such as Tiny Mustang Academy, Family Fun Read Night, H.E.A.R.T program, FUN FAIR, SPARK and H.U.G.S. events. The applicant selected will gain knowledge in careers related to Human Services, Communication, and Business Management. This will also be an asset when applying to college. The applicant will also assist the high school by serving as a teacher's assistant on a daily basis to help complete the hours and working with FRYSC Coordinator at all the events listed above to obtain 300 hours. I will schedule the applicant 8-12 hours each week and

follow up by monitoring, also requiring time sheets to be completed each

week.

The district offers free lunch and breakfast for each student no matter what the family income. Our school has applied for a health snack grant and our students are given a free fruit for snack three times a week. Even with all that support we still have students in need. Our schools free and reduced numbers are 84.63%. The FRYSC Coordinator and applicant will work together to make snack bags for each classroom for those days when fruit isn't provided, organizing a food drive for needed families and preparing food backpacks for students in need for the weekends.

3. How will you provide "on the job mentoring" and supervision for the YSC Corps member?

I will be working side by side on the events listed, I will have firsthand experiences with the students and I always have a support team with me such as, certified teachers, Para-educator, and others FRYSC Coordinators. When the student is working at the high school the teacher will be the supervision and if there is a problem they will report to me and the coordinators for the student assistant teachers program at the high school.

4. Describe students who would be a good fit for this program. How will you promote the program and choose an applicant by August 15?

The students must have a GPA of 3.5 and able to maintain that while serving. The student needs to be a person who wants to serve others and work to make their communities better. They will need to show leadership skills on a daily basic and obtain good common sense. Also have a Kentucky driver's license and plan on attending college to further their education. I will promote the program by working with the Betsy Layne High School Guidance Counselor to insure that the students interested will meet the requirements.
