Attached is the MOA between Summit Learning and Bullitt County Public Schools for Zoneton and Bullitt Lick Middle School. Zoneton Middle School would like to continue offering Summitt to their entire school. Bullitt Lick Middle School would like to expand their implementation to include both 6th and 7th graders.

Per the MOA, Summit Learning will provide professional development and school coaching through program mentors, who are education leaders with experience in teaching and mentoring for personalized directed learning. Summit assigned Mary Kircher as the mentor to work directly with both Zoneton and Bullitt Lick Middle School. Summit will continue to provide workshops, webinars, and other online or in-person learning opportunities, at Summit's discretion.

In order to better equip Bullitt Lick, all new ELA, Math, Social Studies, and Science teachers implementing Summit Learning Platform will be attending a regional training July 8, 2019 through July 11, 2019 in Louisville, KY. All new Zoneton Middle School will attend training June 24, 2019 through June 28, 2019 a different time due to conflict with Ms. Bell, who was accepted in the Leadership Institute. Whenever the team of teachers attends the Professional Learning, they with support from Summit Learning, will continue to explore how the new Kentucky Academic Standards are embedded in the Focus Areas and Cognitive Skills, which are the two forms of assessment in the Summitt Platform.
