WHEREAS, the City of Morehead proposes to acquire/develop/or renovate recreational resources to provide for the health and well-being of the general public, and

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead plans to complete the Triplett Valley Trial project with an estimated cost up to \$426,438, and

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead intends to make application to the Department for Local Government for assistance under the Recreational Trails Program (RTP), federally funded by the Federal Highway Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program is limited to funding a maximum of eighty percent (80%) up to \$250,000 of proposed project costs, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Morehead hold in reserve up to \$176,438, per the amended memorandum of understanding with Daniel Boone Rails to Trails, for the purpose of matching the Recreational Trails Program assistance, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event a grant is awarded, the City of Morehead understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations, especially Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and Section 504 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act.
