RE: Request for Increase of Paid Meal Prices for SY 19-20

### Paid Lunch Equity Pricing for Student Paid Meals

In accordance with the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 and child nutrition program regulation 7 CFR 210.14(e), sponsors of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) must ensure that "sufficient funds are provided to the nonprofit school food service account for meals served to students not eligible for free or reduced price meals." Sponsors of the program have two options in meeting this requirement: 1) Using the Paid Lunch Equity tool to determine the necessity of an increase in the paid lunch meal price and increase the paid lunch meal price to said amount; or 2) Using other non-Federal funding sources in lieu of raising paid lunch meal price.

School Food Service requests approval for an increase of the paid lunch meal price to \$2.85, an increase of ten (10) cents, for SY 19-20. This increase to the paid lunch meal price would apply to all grade levels and schools. The current price for paid lunch meals for SY 18-19, is \$2.75. Student reduced price lunch is set by federal regulation at \$0.40.

School Food Service also requests approval for an increase of the paid breakfast meal price to \$1.50, an increase of twenty-five (.25) cents, for SY 19-20. Note that the BCPS breakfast meal price has not been increased in the past ten years, in order to sustain program operations, it is imperative that the breakfast meal price be raised to cover the cost of service. This increase to the paid breakfast meal price would apply to all grade levels and schools. The current price for paid breakfast meals for SY 18-19, is \$1.25. Student reduced price breakfast is set by federal regulation at \$0.30.

### Adult Meal Pricing

Per FNS 785-2 Rev.1, all adult meal prices for breakfast and lunch must be priced so that the adult payment is sufficient to cover the overall cost of the meal including any USDA reimbursement and value of donated commodities. To maintain compliance with this requirement, School Food Service requests approval for an increase to the adult breakfast meal

price to \$2.75, (a twenty-five cent increase), and to allow adult lunch meal prices to remain at \$3.75, for SY 19-20. This increase to the adult breakfast meal price would keep our pricing in compliance with USDA requirements.
