- As of 5/16/19 48 out of 51 seniors (94%) are on track to graduate and participate in our annual commencement ceremony that's scheduled for May 24<sup>th</sup>. Final grades for seniors are due by 4pm on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.
- As of 5/16/19 the following percentage of grade-level cohorts are considered Transition Ready (Academic and/or Career Ready):
  - 12<sup>th</sup> 39 out of 52 (75%)
  - 11th 18 out of 54 (33%)
  - 10th 3 out of 54 (6%)
  - $\circ$  9<sup>th</sup> 1 out of 60 (2%)
- Gateway dual credit classes wrapped up the second week of May with 27 students completing a total of 106 classes during the 2018-2019 school year. A couple seniors challenged themselves this school year by taking additional college courses at their own expense.
- The ASK assessment was administered to Business students on Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- KPREP testing took place from May 8<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>.
- On May 6<sup>th</sup>, representatives from the Women's Crisis Center visited senior English classes, again, to complete their comprehensive presentation on domestic violence prevention and healthy relationships.
- On May 8<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>, SFC Jason Nolen from the US Army visited DHS during high school lunchtimes.
- On Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, the Civics assessment was administered to 6 seniors who had not previously taken it. All students passed!
- Our annual KPREP Grill Out for those students who demonstrated Good Faith Effort on KPREP testing took place on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. Community and cafeteria members helped serve students hot dogs, hamburgers, etc. Transition Ready seniors had fun throwing pies in faculty members' faces <sup>(i)</sup>
- Middle School and High School awards ceremonies took place on Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Senior Awards Banquet took place on Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. Twelve seniors were awarded \$13,950.00 from local organizations and businesses.
- On Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, our graduating seniors will do our annual Graduation Walk up Greendevil Lane and through the halls of LES. All DHS faculty/staff and community members are encouraged to line up along Greendevil Lane at 8:30am to praise the Class of 2019!
