West Point Independent School District DISTRCT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT*

A public hearing was held at the <u>West Point Independent Schools Elementary Library</u> on <u>April 18, 2019</u>, at <u>5:30</u> (local time). The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a new District Facility Plan developed by the <u>West Point</u> Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted <u>vote record 6 - Yes and 0 - No</u> in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board voted <u>vote record 5 - Yes and 0 - No</u> to approve the new plan.

There was/were (8) <u>number of persons at the hearing exclusive of the hearing officer</u> individual(s) in attendance. <u>Doug Mobley, Director of Special Education</u>, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer. <u>Briefly note those who were present</u>, Those present were Fran Moore, Mickey Brangers, Rozelle Moore, Ron McCreary, Donna McCreary, Jo Sabol, Lena McVey, and Pam Brown.

COMMENTS

<u>Doug Mobley, Hearing Officer</u> called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. It was explained that those persons wishing to speak would be given the opportunity and that written statements would be accepted. All considerations will be made available to the Kentucky Board of Education via the hearing officer's report. The hearing officer read the proposed new District Facility Plan which includes; <u>there are no capital construction priorities until after the 2022 Biennium</u>. Those priorities consist of replacing the gym and cafeteria.

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement. Questions were asked the cost per square foot, the FRYSC room, what is a LIPSA room, and the smart boards.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan developed by the <u>West Point Local</u> Planning Committee and adopted by the <u>West Point Independent</u> Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the <u>West Point Independent</u> School District.
