Existing Policy: The Breathitt County School District was most recently designated a state managed district on September 5, 2018.


Summary of Issue: Status updates are attached to this staff note relative to corrective action taken in the Breathitt County School District since the February 6, 2019 board meeting.

Budget Impact: The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) assigns personnel and resources from the Office of Continuous Improvement and Support as well as the Office of Finance and Operations to support the work in state managed school districts. The estimated budget impact to the KDE is approximately \$1.5 million annually in staffing related costs.
