South Middle School Site Improvements

Superintendent Marganna Stanley and Members of the Board,

On June 7<sup>th</sup> one bid was received for the above referenced project, which was priced over the BG-1 by a considerable amount. After speaking with multiple contractors, we have learned that due to their current workload and the quick construction timeframe that this project required, most chose not to submit a bid. From information we received from the sole bidder, the high price of the project was in part due to the time constraints of the project timeline requiring a substantial amount of overtime and added chemical soil stabilization due to the lack of time to let the soil air-dry.

Many of the contractors did express that if the timeline for completion of this project was extended, they would be able to submit a price if it was re-bid.

It is our recommendation to reject and re-bid the project with a revised project schedule and scope including the following cost saving measures:

- Adequate time for the project to be completed in a timely yet cost efficient manner
- Elimination of irrigation
- Elimination of underdrain system
- Creation of alternate bids for portion of Pre-Engineered Alum Canopy
- Elimination of tree removal from scope of GC work.
