## **Sports Medicine Agreement**

This agreement is between Baptist Health System, Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation, it's Physicians, Certified Athletic Trainers, Physical Therapists, Physical Therapist Assistants, and Exercise Physiologists (hereby referred to as Sports Medicine), and the Hopkins County School District (hereby referred to as School) entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_day of July, 2019 as follows:

Sports Medicine agrees to provide the following services to the school system, its employees, parents or athletes for the annual cost of \$10,000.00 per High School for a total annual cost of \$20.000.00.

- 1. Provide Athletic Training services to include both preventative and immediate medical care to School's athletes. When covering an event, the Athletic Trainer will be the school's designee to determine initial care and management of the athlete's injuries. Coverage will commence with the beginning of formal practices (per KHSAA definitions) of the fall sport seasons (to include football, boy and girl soccer) and end with the completion of the spring sport seasons baseball and softball). The Athletic Trainer will make themselves available for athletic injury checks in order to screen, develop a plan and initiate care. Coverage would also include home Varsity events to include football, Boys' & Girls' soccer, Boys' and Girls' Basketball, Baseball and softball as determined with the Athletic Director and Athletic Training staff availability. Remaining sport teams would be provided through routine athletic injury checks. The Athletic Trainer's coverage schedule of events and practices will be approved by the Athletic Director.
- Develop with the Athletic Director and Team Physician and Emergency Medical Plan to include various athletic practice and completion sites and sports. Communication, supplies and designation of people for specific responsibilities are some of the elements to be developed.
- 3. The Athletic Trainer will be accessible for consultation by cell phone by parents, physician's, coaches, and administrators.
- 4. The Athletic Trainer will be nationally certified and state licensed.
- 5. The Athletic Trainer will be responsible for maintenance, organization and requisitioning of all sports medicine supplies. The School will be responsible for purchasing the necessary supplies.
- 6. Membership to Sports Medicine's Fitness Formula for all roistered athletes can be obtained by attending our Pre-participation Athletic Physical Examination. If unable, membership can be obtained through a discounted fee. Coaches' and administrator' memberships will also be provided.
- 7. Annual Pre-participation for Athletic Physical Examinations sponsored by Sports Medicine. Date and location to be determined by Sports Medicine.
- 8. Hydration Program to include coolers and water bottles for Varsity sports with quantity as determined by Sports Medicine.
- 9. Strength and Conditioning consultation resource for team conditioning programs by Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialists and? or Exercise Physiologists.

Sports Medicine's Physicians, Certified Athletic Trainers, Physical Therapist, and Exercise Physiologist will become the sports medicine team for the School's Boy and Girl's athletic program. Any student athlete entering Sports Medicine's healthcare system as a patient must be insured appropriately.

As consideration for this agreement, Sports Medicine reserves the right to represent itself as the exclusive provider of sports medicine and the School is to receive the above mentioned services. Sports Medicine will have first refusal of sponsorship of School's athletic teams to include but not limited to special events, tournaments, or uniforms in regards to the marketing category of athletic training or physical therapy. School will allow display of signage at covered events, space in sports programs, and acknowledgement of services with the use of the PA system at all athletic venues at no cost. This agreement does not preclude a parent's right to independently seek out the physician of their choice after initial medical care has been provided by Sports Medicine.

This agreement shall be for a period of two years as described by the School and will be automatically renewed. Notwithstanding the duration of this agreement, either party may terminate this agreement upon a 60 day notice to the other party in writing.
