Facilities, Transportation, Regional School and Safe Schools

Transportation:

- Aaron Hunt with Thomas Controls continues evaluating our HVAC systems work at NHS. During my time in this position we have continued to have repeated issues. Therefore, we have decided to have a third party come in and inspect the system and provide us a report on each project. We have completed the evaluation on the 15 16 project. Now we are looking into the 17 18 work and we have started finding some issues with this as well.
