

ORDINANCE 18-2019

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 12-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2280 TAMARACK ROAD, CONTAINING 48.296 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019 the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 12-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 2280 Tamarack Road, containing approximately 48.296 acres, more or less; and,

WHEREAS, since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 12-2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 12-2019 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
