Hopkins County Schools Virtual Academy

The Hopkins County Schools Virtual Academy (HCSVA) will provide at-risk students with an alternate route to an education and even a high school diploma. Students in grades six through twelve may be assigned to the HCSVA by court order or by district/superintendent decision. Programs and services focus on preparing students for a smooth transition to a traditional high school setting, post-secondary institution, the workplace or service in the armed forces.

The HCSVA will collaborate with the court system, parents/guardians, local law enforcement agencies and area social service agencies to focus on the needs of this unique group of students.

For the HCSVA program, students will be enrolled through the Hopkins County Schools Academy, but they will not attend school on campus or participate in sports, extra or co-curricular activities, or school functions; instead, students will receive a well-rounded education off campus through an online provider that will be monitored by district/school personnel.
