## RE: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN THE BOONE COUNTY ALTERNATIVE CENTER FOR EDUCATION AND TRI-STATE CANINE OBEDIENCE

The dog therapy program is designed to aid at-risk students at ACE with behavioral awareness in order to divert behaviors classified in the Safe Schools Report as "unsafe;" in partnership with Tri-State Canine Obedience. Tri-State C.O. will create a personalized curriculum that will allow students to create a self-sustaining program that rescues dogs and trains them to become certified therapy dog trainers.

Students will have the ability to exhibit the Boone County School Districts 10 C's; specifically: Compassion- The objective is for the students to own community needs by rescuing dogs then training to adopt out to other schools for therapy assistance; Collaboration-Students will partner with an outside consultant expert dog training and then engage among other students by working together to train a therapy dog; Community; Connections-Working with other schools to determine their needs for a more Safe School by utilizing a therapy dog; and Critical Thinking-The students will guide other schools stakeholders how to obtain funds through a self-created fundraising program within the school to have a therapy dog.
