Administration KiNVO Communication

Administration Communication Metrics*

- Family Resources & Youth Service Center Coordinators (FRYSC) and School Nurses have exchanged 5,000 messages with parents.
- School level administrators at the three KiNVO schools have exchanged 47,400 with parents:
 - Cooper High School: 3,701 messages exchanged
 - Conner High School: 7,707 messages exchanged
 - Jones Middle School: 35,992 messages exchanged

School Feedback

"We have engaged with more ENL families this year than ever before by using KiNVO. In some cases, this is the first time we have been able to communicate with some of our eighth-grade parents, and they have been with us for three years."

Attendance Impact

From February SY 2017-2018 to February SY 2018-2019:

- Cooper High School experienced a 0.17% increase in attendance
- Rector A Jones Middle School experienced a 0.05% increase in attendance
