4.A. Ordinance 18-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 12-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2280 TAMARACK ROAD, CONTAINING 48.296 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Commissioner Smith-Wright and a second by Commissioner Sanford.

On June 4, 2019, the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 12-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 2280 Tamarack Road, containing approximately 48.296 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 12-2019.

4.B. Ordinance 19-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 13-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED

AT 4610 and 4514 GOETZ DRIVE AND 1621 SOUTHTOWN DRIVE, CONTAINING 52.238 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Mayor Watson and a second by Commissioner Smith-Wright.

On June 4, 2019, the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 13-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 4610 and 4514 Goetz Drive and 1621 Southtown Drive, containing approximately 52.238 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 13-2019.

4.C. Consider Ordinance 20-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 14-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019 DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1622 SOUTHEASTERN PARKWAY, CONTAINING 6.370 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Mayor Watson and a second by Commissioner Sanford.

On June 4, 2019 the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 14-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 1622 Southeastern Parkway, containing 6.370 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 14-2019.

4.D. Consider Ordinance 21-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 15-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 4255 NEW HARTFORD ROAD, CONTAINING 31.683 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Mayor Watson and a second by Commissioner Smith-Wright.

On June 4, 2019 the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 15-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 4255 New Hartford Road, containing 31.683 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 15-2019.

4.E. Consider Ordinance 22-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 16-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE

OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 6000 FAIRVIEW DRIVE, CONTAINING 22.799 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Mayor Watson and a second by Commissioner Conder.

On June 4, 2019 the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 16-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 6000 Fairview Drive, containing 22.799 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 16-2019.

4.F. Consider Ordinance 23-2019 entitled AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 17-2019 IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON JUNE 4, 2019, DECLARING THE CITY OF OWENSBORO'S INTENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIESS ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CITY, BEING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2909 HIGHWAY 54, CONTAINING 14.877 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, was unanimously approved on second reading with a motion by Mayor Watson and a second by Commissioner Smith-Wright.

On June 4, 2019 the Owensboro Board of Commissioners approved Ordinance 17-2019 declaring the City's intent to annex into the City certain unincorporated territory in the County of Daviess adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being property located at 2909 Highway 54, containing 14.877 acres, more or less. Since that time, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of all parties involved to repeal Ordinance 17-2019.
