

Standard 1: Personal Leadership

Monthly or bi-monthly modules, aligned to session schedule, to introduce session concepts and prepare for the in-person session

- 90 minutes in length ٠
- Viewed on participants' own time; however, must be completed in advance of the local session

Sessions

- Monthly, 4 hour meetings to introduce, reinforce ٠ and practice content in an interactive, safe environment
- Session days and start/end times vary depending ٠ upon program city

Learning Meetings & Coaching **Sessions**

- Learning Meetings are formal feedback benchmarks, where participants reflect upon their progress to-date; criteria for preparation will be shared in advance of each meeting
- Each Emerging Leader will receive 10-12 hours of coaching
- Sessions will take place in-person, on the phone or ٠ virtually; we will hold a minimum of 2 in-person coaching meetings
