**PAINTSVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT**

A public hearing was held at the Paintsville High School Media Center on 05/15/19 at 5:30 P.M. (local time). The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a District Facility Plan developed by the Paintsville Independent Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 6-0 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board of Education voted 5-0 to approve the new plan.

There was no one in attendance from the public. Joe Schmitt, District Finance Officer, was present. Tim Eaton, KSBA Field Consultant, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer.

COMMENTS

Tim Eaton called the public hearing to order and read the agenda. There was no one from the public present at the hearing. The hearing officer highlighted the proposed new District Facility Plan as follows; Under Capital Construction Priorities (Scheduled within the 2020-2022 Biennium) 1d., the plan lists District White Board Initiative, renovation to Paintsville Elementary 1965, 1987, and 2014 to upgrade classroom technology. Also, to upgrade classroom technology at Paintsville Middle and High School 1952, 1996, 2001, 2009 and 2017 sections. Under item 1e., upgrade all existing facilities to meet the most current life safety requirements of the Kentucky Building Code. Under item 1f., renovation to upgrade all existing facilities to meet the most current handicap accessibility requirements of the Kentucky Building Code. Under Capital Construction Priorities (Schedule after the 2020-2022 Biennium) 2b., lists major renovation to Paintsville Elementary 1965, 1987 and 2014 portions of the building. Also, major renovation to Paintsville Middle and High School 1952, 1996, 2001 and 2017 portions of the building. Under 4. Management Support Areas, it calls for major renovation to Central Office and construction of a new 2 bay Bus Garage. Finally, Discretionary Construction Projects for Paintsville Middle and High School include construction of football locker room storage and a football press box, construct and develop a soccer field, renovate softball and baseball fields to include fencing, dugouts, bleachers, scoreboard and press box.

Again, there was no one present at the hearing and no written comments were submitted. The hearing was adjourned.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan as developed by the Paintsville Independent Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Paintsville Independent Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Paintsville Independent School District. A copy of the new plan is attached.
