College Trip: (Western or MSU) 10-15 students. \$400. February. We take students who are first generation/borderline academic achievement students on a college visit and provide lunch.

Rake & Run: 130 students. \$50. November. Students are taken to a near by neighborhood to rake their yards and to leave an appreciation note/candy. The neighborhoods are chosen by geographical close distance as to soften relations and bring together school and community.
