It's no secret that school budgets are tight, often leaving various programs underfunded. In an effort to devise a creative, low-pressure fund-raising opportunity, Ford launched the Drive 4 UR School test-drive program in 2007. Ford offers a \$20 donation for each valid test-drive, up to \$6,000 total*, which can be used for sports, booster clubs, music programs and the many other miscellaneous expenses associated with running a school.

A standard Drive 4 UR School Event

Program HQ will verify that all Drive 4 UR School events are operating within PMA guidelines. If there is a PMA violation, dealers and regional personnel will be notified within 30 days of enrolling in order to seek resolution. Events violating PMA boundaries are subject to cancellation. If you are unsure what your PMA boundaries are, please contact your Zone Manager.

Your event kit will be shipped to arrive at the dealership three to four weeks before your scheduled event day. It is important to open your event kit upon delivery to ensure that all of the necessary items are included and none have been damaged in transit. In an effort to be green, you will receive a complete event kit for only the first Drive 4 UR School event you host in 2017. A "Kit Light" will then be sent to any subsequent Drive 4 UR School events you host this year. A list of items found in the complete and light kits can be found on the website at https://forddrive4ur.com/important_info. Please hold on to kit items from the first complete kit for use in future events. Since these packages are being sent to the dealership, be sure to stay in close communication with the school so that everyone has their materials as early as possible. Early preparation will yield the most successful event. We encourage you to visit the program website, forddrive4ur.com, for more information about the Drive 4 UR School program. Additional Drive 4 UR School promotional materials, event planning tips and branded creative materials are available for download on our website at no extra cost! You can also use the program website to track the shipments of both your event kit and donation check by utilizing our "Event Kit and Donation Status" feature, found on the "Enroll an Event" page under "My Events."

If circumstances arise that may require you to change some aspects of your event, you must complete an Event Change Request form, found on the Program Materials page, and submit it to drive4urschool@gtb.com at least three weeks prior to your scheduled event date.

Should an extenuating circumstance prohibit you from submitting your request within this three week time frame, please contact Program HQ directly.
