Health Science is Stocking up on Supplies

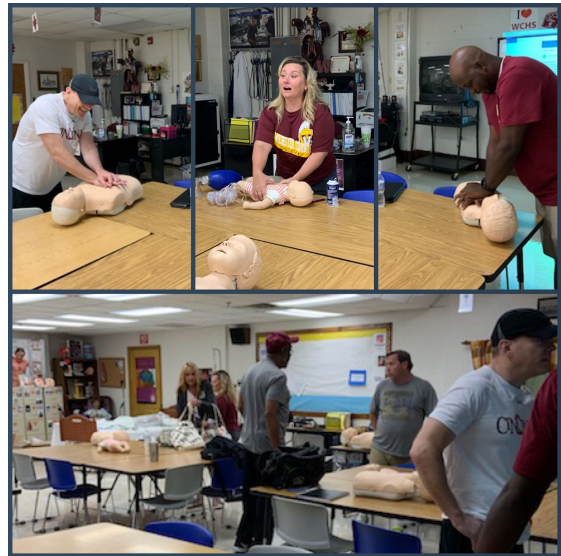
