3. PROPERTY MAINTENANCE – Wayne Shelton, Public Works Director, explained the Property Maintenance Department's goals, staff changes, demolition process and upcoming proposed ordinance changes (presentation attached). Recent budget changes have allowed for the replacement of one (1) part-time inspector with one (1) full-time inspector and the addition of one (1) part-time clerk has increased inspections, re-inspections, notice of violations and citations. The increased budget allocation has also led to additional demolitions.

4. OBKY BUDGET REPORT - Lelan Hancock, Assistant City Manager introduced the final product of the OBKY Budget Report (attached). The summarized, condensed budget report is now available on the City's website.

5. CITY PROJECT LIST – City Manager Nate Pagan announced the Dog Park ribbon cutting for August 20, 2019. Engineering has inspected the recent sidewalk complaint from Shelborn Drive. Mayor Watson asked if the paving list could be posted online. Wayne Shelton, Public Works Director responded that the list is ever-changing and it would not be feasible. A brief update was given on the Bluegrass Music Museum punch list and the Fisher Park renovation.

6. CLOSED SESSION – Motion was made by Mayor Watson and seconded by Commissioner Conder to enter into a Closed Session under KRS 61.810(1)(c) to discuss proposed or pending litigation; motion carried unanimously.
