Remove-

Under the new state attendance guidelines a child that is late to school or leaves early and the total time accumulated is 60 minutes or less will be counted as tardy. If the time exceeds 60 minutes the child will be counted absent for the total number of minutes that are accumulated.

The Board encourages parents, professional educators, and others who have legitimate educational interests pertaining to the District's public school program to visit the schools. ASSAULT AND THREATS OF VIOLENCE
