(Section 1). Daily Attendance. Change to correct citations to the wrong section of 704 KAR 3:305. Change to correct individual education program (IEP) from incorrect individual education plan (IEP).

(Section 2). Calculation of Attendance. No change.

(Section 3). Shortened School Day. No change.

(Section 4). Dual Enrollment. No change.

(Section 5). Private School Placement. No change.

(Section 6). Age of Pupil. Amend to replace outdated language only applicable to school years prior to 2017-18. Clarify that students under the age of compulsory education and enrolled pursuant to a district's evaluation policy are eligible for inclusion in ADA. (KRS 158.030).

(Section 7). Due Dates for Certain Reports. No change.

(Section 8). Nonresident Pupils. Amend to change required due date for execution of agreements between districts from February to October of the school year prior to the school year in which it will apply. Include appeal procedures for nonresident disagreements between districts.

(Section 9). Weather-related Low Attendance Days. Make changes to clarify requirements.

(Section 10.) Health and Safety Closings. Clarify that these days only apply to districts with an approved Non-traditional Instruction (NTI) program per KRS 158.070(10).

(Section 11). Original Source of Attendance Data. No Change.

(Section 12). Enrollment Codes. Amend "E03" code to cleanup outdated references for a pupil enrolling for the first time during current school year. Amend "W07" to clarify that it also applies to a hospital setting. Amend "W24" to clarify that it applies to a no show student that subsequently enrolls in the district.

(Section 13). Suspension. No change.

(Section 14). Ethnicity. No change.

(Section 15). Racial Category Codes. No change.

(Section 16). Withdrawal and Transfer Records. Amend to strike reference to student dropout questionnaire. The change in dropout law in Kentucky negates the necessity for a questionnaire. Districts may choose to use a questionnaire but are not required.

(Section 17). Incorporation by Reference. Update forms and reports as necessary.
