#### **Day 1 Tuesday, March 31, 2020**

10:00 PM We will depart from Harrodsburg, Kentucky for Williamsburg making stops in route. *I have allowed 2 hours for stopping and traffic*

#### **Day 2 Wednesday, April 1, 2020**

9:00 AM Estimated arrival time in Williamsburg. **Guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg** - the only place that takes you back in time to the dawn of America. This isn't just a place where things once happened. They're happening, right now, here in the 18th century. We're the place where the idea of our country is being born; the place where the ideals we stand for as Americans are being defined. We are the 18th century "live," filled with the stories of the women, men, and children—free and enslaved—whose values and visions gave us a new world. Step back in time and meet the people who made America—sing with them, dance with them, eat with them, and have fun with them. For every person who wants to understand this country, this is your place.

7:00 PM **Shadows of the Past Ghost Tour** - The best of both worlds! With Shadows of the Past, students have the opportunity to experience both 18th Century and modern ghost stories inside the buildings and on the streets of the country's oldest living museum. Costumed storytellers present stories that gave colonial Americans a fright; and share tales of ghosts in town that have lingered to send a shiver down our spines today.

#### **Day 3 Thursday, April 2, 2020**

7:30 AM **Breakfast** at the hotel this morning

9:00 AM **Jamestown Settlement** - Near the site of the original colony, Jamestown Settlement tells the story of 17th-century Virginia, from the arrival of English colonists in Jamestown in 1607 to the cultural encounters and events that planted the seeds of a new nation. The world of Jamestown, America's first permanent English colony, comes to life through film, gallery exhibits and outdoor living history.

**Lunch included** at Jamestown Settlement or Museum

1:30 PM **American Revolution Museum at Yorktown** - The American Revolution Museum at Yorktown tells the story of the nation's founding, from the twilight of the colonial period to the dawn of the Constitution and beyond. Exciting indoor galleries feature period artifacts, immersive environments, interactive exhibits and films, including "The Siege of Yorktown," with a 180-degree surround screen and dramatic special effects. Outdoors, enlist in Continental Army in a re-created encampment to learn about the life of a soldier and take in daily demonstrations on medical treatment, camp life and cooking, and see firings of musket and artillery. Explore a Revolution-era farm, based on a real-life 18th-century family, to help with chores in the house, kitchen, tobacco barn, gardens and crops.

The state-operated museum of the American Revolution, named one of the New York Times' 52 Places to Visit in 2019, is an excellent starting point for a tour of Yorktown.
