

## Dayton Kindergarten Readiness Screening Data 2019

- Of those 75 screened 17 have IEP's and 3 of them were Ready. That is 23% of the class receiving special education services.
- Of those screened **READY**:
  - 7 attended Head Start
  - 17 attended Lincoln Elementary
  - 10 attended other early childhood settings
  - 1 was Home and had no prior setting or experiences
  - 4 were Ready with Enrichments
- Of those screened **Not Ready**:
  - 9 attended Head Start
  - 16 attended Lincoln Elementary
  - 5 attended other early childhood settings
  - 10 were Home and had no prior setting or experiences
- Overall strength areas were math cognitive/academic concepts including (sorting objects, rote counting, matching quantities with numerals and totaling two sets).
- Language skills and self-help skills were an increase with more students being average to above average in these areas.
- Overall weaknesses were in the areas of literacy cognitive skills and physical development, specifically fine motor skills.
