## **Transportation:**

- Library projects are complete. Final flooring touchups took place on Monday. This only leaves the remaining furniture which has not arrived.
- Surplus sale was completed. Biggest items to sale: NHS generator and International tractor at bus lot. Will be making arrangements to clear out all items at the grainry so we can eliminate that monthly bill.
- Pumps at the stadium have been completed.
- New football scoreboard has been ordered.
- AC at Primary kitchen was installed over the break.
- LED lights at Primary are continuing to be installed. First floor has been mostly completed.
- Waiting on bid for blinds at NPS and NIS.
- Making adjustments to KFICS report for the state.
- Finally finishing up HVAC issues from 15-16, 16-17, and 17-18 projects. We should be able to recoup some money from the projects.
- Freezer at NHS went out on Friday and had to be worked on. We were lucky and able to get it through the night and repaired on Saturday.
- Need water heaters at both NIS and NPS. Mr. Turner currently getting BG for this project. This will probably run us \$90-100K.
- Mr. Grayson will be attending the state Ky School Plant Managers Association meeting on Wednesday and Thursday of this week in Lexington.
