

Parent Involvement Report

October 29, 2019

As a result of the 2019 Parent Teacher Conferences conducted in September, the schools reported the following participation:

Franklin Elementary -had **335** total parent conferences. 213 of 243 students represented during Parent Teacher Conferences for Kindergarten and 122 of 122 Preschool students.

Simpson Elementary- had **951** parents involved since the beginning of school. 477 Parent Teacher conferences. 364 participated in the Grandparent breakfast and 110 for the All Pro Dads event.

Lincoln Elementary-had **854** parent/guardians participate in school events since the beginning of school. 335 total Parent Teacher conferences were conducted, 244 attended the Grandparents breakfast, and 275 attended the Open House.

Franklin-Simpson Middle School- had a total of **240** parent contacts. Team Honor met with 31 parents, Team Courage had 21 parent contacts, Team Hope made 62 parent contacts, Team Integrity had 32 parent contacts, Team Respect had 39 parent contacts, Team Perseverance had 34 parent contacts, Related Arts Team had 14, and Team Caring made 7 parent contacts.

Franklin-Simpson High School-had a total of **144** Parent Teacher Conferences. Parent contact has been added to Weekly Overviews.

Franklin Simpson-West Campus- had a total of **8** students represented in conferences.

Total Parents Involved= 2,532 This is a decrease of 100 parent contacts from this same time last year. However, it is a huge increase from the spring conferences. As a district, we are making an intentional effort to find ways to involve more parents. We realize that engaging ALL stakeholders, especially our parents, will increase student achievement.
