Receive the report of Students Involved in School Sponsored Activities for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years

**APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:**

District-Wide Goals: Goal 8 "Beginning in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, ALL students will participate in at least one activity providing a meaningful connection to school beyond the regular classroom.

**HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

The Student Engagement Coordinator (SEC) collaborates with Principals, Athletic Directors, and Activity Coordinators to ensure schools are working to achieve Goal 8. SEC meets with the schools prior to, beginning, during, and at the end of the year to emphasize positive relationship between student involvement and student achievement. Student Activity Surveys are administered to all 4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders to identify student involvement and interests. Using data collected thru the Activity Survey, schools initiate plans to connect with students not involved and possibly add new activities. SEC reviews data collection process, shares and supports strategies for engagement opportunities across the District.

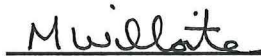

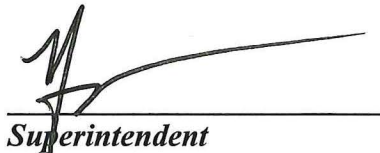

**Kenton County School District Goal 8: Beginning in 4th grade ALL KCSD students will participate in at least one activity providing a meaningful connection to school beyond the regular classroom.**

**Before school year:**

- Meet with district level support staff
- Plan for what can be done by the schools before day 1 of the school year
  - Activity fairs
  - Open house info
  - Website info
  - Planning activity periods in school day schedule
- Look into programs that district can develop in cooperation with schools

**Beginning of the school year:**

- Meet individually with Secondary Principals
- Meet with building activity support staff elementary, middle, high school
  - Discuss rationale for activity involvement
  - Review goals for the district/school
- Student Activity Involvement Surveys – Complete before Thanksgiving (secondary), end of the school year (elementary)
  - Engaging new student who enroll throughout the year
- Ideas to promote activities ongoing (announcements, video streaming, social media, faculty meetings, assemblies, newsletters)
- How to add activities (process)—climate of encouraging staff to encourage students
- Update school level activity list document (name of activity – who to contact if interested)
- Organize list of students not involved for outreach

**Throughout the school year:**

- Maximize involvement in current activities and grow new ones
- Celebrate activity accomplishments
- Analyze the survey data (school level)
- School wide approach to outreach to “not involved” students
  - Find out who is not involved and why
  - Encourage those kids and plug them in
  - Cross reference the data with At Risk (grades, discipline, attend, poverty) to prioritize
  - Include discussion about activity involvement when talking about or with kids

**End of the school year:**

- Gather activity superlatives by school (sports and otherwise)
- Gather involvement percentages for individual schools – Elementary outreach throughout the year – participation survey students in April - Secondary outreach in fall, participation surveys in December, outreach in January, update final participation percentages in April
- Begin planning for next school year
