

VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

Career and Technical Education programs are planned course sequences of high-quality academic core content and technical skills, which focus on a specific career cluster and prepare students to successfully transition toward their career goal. Students demonstrate mastery of standards for pathways by obtaining an *Industry Certification* and/or receiving a passing score (70%) on the *CTE EOP (End of Program) Assessment for Articulated Credit* in their program area.

Newport High School offers 12 Career Pathways:

- Accounting (IC or CTE EOP)
- Administrative Support (IC or CTE EOP)
- Management Entrepreneurship (IC or CTE EOP)
- Marketing (IC or CTE EOP)
- Construction TRACK (TRACK Assessment)
- Graphic Design (IC or CTE EOP)
- Consumer & Family Management (IC or CTE EOP)
- Early Childhood Education (IC or CTE EOP)
- Fundamentals of Teaching (IC only)
- Printing & Finishing (IC only)
- Residential Carpenter Assistant (IC only)
- PLTW Biomedical Sciences (IC only)

Students preview the pathways and conference with teachers and administrative staff during the Spring of their 8th-grade year to determine the best "fit" for each. Students are educated on the necessary courses to complete a pathway and schedules are amended if necessary.

We have 73 seniors in one or more CTE Pathways.

DUAL CREDIT

We have 11 juniors and 12 seniors attending Gateway. Four of these students (2 juniors and 2 seniors) are in the Logistics program (the new Vocational Certification Program started with Navigo/River Cities that is also run through Gateway).

We have 1 senior attending NKU.

Students request to enroll in dual credit when completing their course requests. Students are notified if they meet admissions qualifications. Students complete the college's application to attend dual credit.
