This is on the Kentucky Regulatory Statute 158.854, enacted in 2005, and requires the state Board of Education to promulgate an administrative regulation to specify the minimum nutritional standards for food and beverages sold outside the school meal programs. As a result, Kentucky Administrative Regulation 702, Section 6.090 was established. As of July 1, 2014, Kentucky schools must adhere to whichever standard is more restrictive—the U.S. Department of Agriculture's interim final rule or state law.

The time between the first student's arrival at the school building and the end of the last instructional period.
