This high tech spot vision camera screens for six amblyopic risk factors (Myopia, Hyperopia, Astigmatism, Anisometropia, Strabismus, and Anisocoria). If indicated, referrals were made for a more detailed eye exam with an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist.
