To review the status of corrective action being taken in the state assisted school district, Menifee County Schools.

BACKGROUND:

Existing Policy:

The Menifee County School District was designated a state assisted district on June 5, 2019.

Summary of Issue:

Status updates are attached to this staff note relative to corrective action taken in the Menifee County School District since the June 5, 2019 board meeting.

Budget Impact:

The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) assigns personnel and resources from the Office of Continuous Improvement and Support as well as the Office of Finance and Operations to support the work in state assisted school districts. The estimated budget impact to the KDE is approximately \$100,000 annually in staffing related costs.
