

## **RESOLUTION \_\_:2019**

**WHEREAS**, Captain Kyle Callahan retired from duty on November 30, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, 65.041 permits a city to sell a retiring officer his issued firearm so long as the firearm was issued to the officer as his or her primary service weapon, the officer is authorized by law to own or possess the firearm and the sale price of the firearm is the fair market value, not to exceed the actual cost of the firearm to the city;

**WHEREAS**, Glock Model 17, 9 mm, Serial Number BAGP624, with night sights and three magazines was issued to Captain Kyle Callahan as his primary service weapon;

**WHEREAS**, Kyle Callahan is authorized by law to own or possess said weapon;

**WHEREAS**, per Bypass Pawn Shop in Morehead, Kentucky the fair market value of said weapon is \$225.00;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Morehead, Board of City Council as follows:

1. That Kyle Callahan's primary service weapon, Glock Model 17, 9 mm Serial Number BAGP624, with night sights and three magazines is declared surplus property and said weapon shall be sold to Kyle Callahan for \$225.00.

2. That the proceeds from said transfer shall be utilized solely for the purchase of body armor meeting or exceeding National Institute of Justice standards, firearms, ammunition or range facilities, or a combination thereof in accordance with KRS 65.041.

3. That the Mayor shall have the authority and power to sign any and all documents necessary to transfer said property.
