December 18, 2019

- The College Fair for Seniors was Friday, November 22nd. We had 19 colleges here for our seniors to meet with and learn what each school offers.
- Administration met with NaviGo trainers on Monday, November 25th. The goal of this program is to assist students in learning about career opportunities post high school. We will be implementing this program beginning in January and the instruction will be led by administration.
- We had a guest speaker meet with all middle school students to discuss the dangers of vaping – our guest speaker was Matt Wilhelm from American Red Cross.
