## Breckinridge County Schools Expectations Nonresident Pupils

Nonresident pupils are pupils that do not live in Breckinridge County, but attend school in Breckinridge County. The Breckinridge County Board of Education has agreements (on a reciprocating basis) with surrounding school systems for nonresident students to attend school in Breckinridge County in accordance with the following:

- 1. Nonresident pupils must be in good standing with the previous school district of attendance prior to their enrollment in the District's schools.
- 2. The student shall comply with the District's Attendance Policy.
- 3. The student shall show appropriate academic progress as determined by his/her teacher(s) and the Principal.
- 4. The student shall comply with the District's "Code of Acceptable Behavior and Discipline".
- 5. The student shall comply with the individual school Policies and Procedures.
- 6. The student shall participate fully in all state and county mandated testing programs.
- 7. Nonresident pupils wishing to enroll during the school year will be approved on an individual basis by the Superintendent/Designee.

Violation(s) of this agreement may cause nonresident pupils to be immediately withdrawn from the Breckinridge County School District, and returned to their home district.

#### Exception:

#### **FEES**

According to a schedule adopted annually by the Board, a nonresident student shall be charged tuition equal to the District's basic SEEK allotment, unless the student's district of residence has signed a reciprocal agreement to exchange ADA funds. Students of any District employee may attend tuition free without regard to residence, contingent on the District receiving ADA as provided by law. In cases where the District does receive the ADA on the nonresident student, a processing fee of \$175.00 shall be charged annually.

Tuition fees shall be paid annually in advance or via a payment plan established by the Superintendent. Employees may elect to pay tuition fees through a payroll deduction plan.

Students who voluntarily withdraw from the District shall receive a prorata tuition refund.
