Penny Knight, Principal, Gateway Academy to Innovation and Technology, was present to give the board a PowerPoint update on Career and Technical Education (a copy of which is attached to the minutes.)

Ms. Knight reviewed current initiatives, the different pathways offered at Christian County High School, Gateway and

Hopkinsville High School, current Career and Technical Enrollment numbers and Career and Technical Enrollment 10-year trends. Ms. Knight recognized and thanked Community Partners.

Ms. Knight thanked the Board and Ms. Gemmill for their support in opening the Gateway Academy – Breathitt Campus. The Dedication Plaque honoring the Board and Superintendent Gemmill has been hung at the Breathitt Campus. A picture of the dedication plaque was shown.

Mr. Moore was unable to attend the PBIS meeting this morning, but did receive an update from Kim Stevenson. He stated the goal for 2019-2020 referrals is 5000 and they currently have 2000 referrals mid-year. Mr. Moore stated two schools moved from bronze status to silver status which is Christian County High School and Christian County Middle School. He thanked Ms. Stevenson and her team for all the work they are doing and Principals for putting strategies in place.

The Representatives asked us to make a

prioritized list of issues that they can take back to Frankfort. Mr. Clark stated January will be a budget session with a new Governor and Republicans have a super majority. It will be interesting to watch.
