## 2020-21 Enrollment Projections

- Develop student enrollment projections for initial budget allocations
- Compile annual room usage surveys, floor plans, KDE reports, and Infinite Campus schedules in order to determine optimal building capacities
- Analyze daily projected enrollments to identify past patterns and predict future trends in order to ensure funds are allocated properly to schools



## 2020-21 Enrollment Projections

- Geographic Information Systems (GIS) is used to develop and maintain data
- Data sources
- JCPS district and school enrollment history and trends
- Planning and Zoning pre-applications and active building permits
- Plan 2040 for Louisville Metro
- U.S. Census Bureau

- Kentucky Bureau of Vital Statistics
- Kids Count Data Center
- Louisville-Jefferson County Information Consortium (LOJIC)



## FY21 General Fund School Allocation Standards

- January - Staffing allocations to schools for review with their SBDM councils
- Basic components of the school-based allocations:
- Section 4 Certified Staff
- Section 5 Classified Staff
- Section 6 Non-Instructional Operational
- 3.5\% of State SEEK base per pupil - \$140 per student
- Non-Classroom Staff - based on projected total enrollment
- Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, Librarian, Secretary, Bookkeeper, School Clerk
- Fee Waiver
- Provides funds to assist in paying school fees for students on free and reduced price lunches
- February to March - Schools submit staffing changes based on SBDM decisions
- August $-5^{\text {th }}$ day adjustment based on actual enrollment


## Standard Allocations Classroom Instructional Staff

- ELEMENTARY - Kindergarten through Fifth grade
- Teacher allocation based on student to teacher ratios:
- Kindergarten through $5^{\text {th }}$ grade -24 to 1
- Instructional assistants allocated - 24 to 1 student to teacher ratio at the Kindergarten level
- Special areas (itinerant) teacher allocation - 0.14 teacher allocation for every regular classroom teacher allocation
- Provides general art and music experience for all students
- Provides for planning period for regular education teachers
- MIDDLE - Sixth through Eighth grade
- Teacher allocation student to teacher ratios: $6^{\text {th }}$ grade through $8^{\text {th }}$ grades -28 to 1
- Allocation supports a six-period instructional day.
- Provides each teacher a planning period
- SECONDARY - Ninth through Twelfth grade
- Teacher allocation student to teacher ratio: $9^{\text {th }}$ through $12^{\text {th }}$ grades -28 to 1
- Allocation also supports instructional day for:
- Six-period instructional day
- Trimester
- AB Schedule
- 7-period schedule
- Provides each teacher a planning period
