

CAPE is a disability education program that CCK has developed to create awareness about CCK and the illnesses camp serves. CCK feels that it is important to start educating children at a young age about different disabilities and illnesses.

Through this program, CCK's goal is to teach children of all abilities how to *create* ways to give back, learn how to *advocate* for others, *perform* acts that help their peers with disabilities, and further *educate* the community on what being a hero for each other is truly about.

Allen County students have the power to change lives. In 2008, the Allen County Intermediate Center students started a yearly fundraiser for CCK. Starting out as just a fifth grade fundraising effort, has since then expanded to include the entire school. Since inception, this fundraiser has raised over \$20,000 for CCK. Spearheaded by ACIC teacher, Cheryl Miller, the students raise money by simply bringing in \$1.00 donations in a one month time frame. At the end of the fundraiser, the entire student body comes for a tour of CCK to show what their money goes to. After seeing the success of this program, we were encouraged to expand it to include more schools and to add an educational component.
