Qualification

Students who have received repeated suspensions for offenses that:

- endanger the safety of other students and/or staff
- significantly minimize instructional impact for other students
- erode school climate/culture of high expectations for behavior

Overview

- Traditional Path
 - Must complete ten consecutive days.
 - Behavioral infractions reset time, starting date of infraction.
 - Unexcused absence events reset time, starting date of absence.
 - Must be passing all classes on Edgenuity with a minimum of 60% to exit.
 - If students do not complete ten days within a thirty-day time frame, they will be referred to the School of Innovation.
- Non-Traditional Path
 - Due to social-emotional needs and/or circumstances of behavior event, student will be placed for a designated time period.
 - Counseling support will be offered to family.
 - Student academic performance will be examined at designated junctures by New Pathways teacher and principal to determine next steps.

Students who successfully complete their time in New Pathways are referred to NSOI following their first suspension after transitioning back into the traditional classroom setting.
