#### Stakeholder makes allegation

•Written; phone call; hotline; personal visit (face to face)

#### Allegations are forwarded to respective department

- •Performs inquiry/investigation
- •Determines next step (internal and/or external)

## Report Internally\*

#### Security & Investigations - Reports to Operations Division

• Assaults; burglary; arson; thefts; threats; weapons; child pornography; illegal drugs; vandalism; tresspassing; other criminal activity

## Compliance & Investigations - Reports to General Counsel

• Equal opportunity; affirmative actions; sexual harrassment; discrimination; misconduct; other Federal compliance issues

## Internal Audit - Reports to Superintendent

•Fraud; special assignments from Superintendent/Cabinet/JCBOE Board members

## Report Externally, may also be concurrently reviewed internally in concert with external partner

## Federal/local law enforcement

#### **Child Protective Services**

Relevant regulatory body (i.e. Local, State (i.e. KDE; Ky Commission on Human Rights etc), Federal (i.e. OCR, EEOC etc.)

## Resolution

- •Superintendent/Cabinet leaders (if appropriate)/Cost Center Head
- Employee Relations
- EPSB (if appropriate certified)
- Legal Action (if appropriate)
