6 RELATES TO: KRS 156.802(5)(b), 156.814, 151B.150, 20 U.S.C. 2342

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 156.802(5)(b), 20 U.S.C. 2342(a)(1)

8 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 156.802(5)(b) designates the Kentucky

9 Board of Education as the sole state agency for developing and approving state plans required by

10 federal law as prerequisites to receiving federal funds for vocational technical or technology

11 education. KRS 156.852 authorizes the agency to promulgate administrative regulations to

12 implement federal vocational education programs. 20 U.S.C. 2342(a)(1) requires the state agency

13 to prepare a state plan for career and technical education as a prerequisite to receiving federal

14 funds under 20 U.S.C. Chapter 44. This administrative regulation establishes and incorporates by

15 reference the Kentucky State Plan for Career and Technical Education (December 2008). 780

16 KAR 1:010 and the document incorporated by reference are no longer in alignment with federal

17 law, which was reauthorized in 2018 under the Strengthening Career and Technical Education

18 for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V), 20 U.S.C. Chapter 44. Kentucky's updated Perkins V state

19 plan is subject to approval by the Kentucky Board of Education, pursuant to such authority

20 granted under KRS 156.802.
